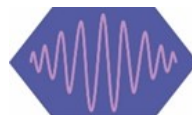




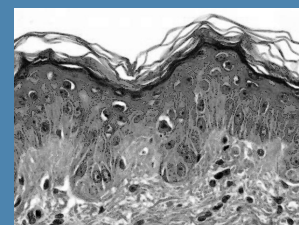

The Symposium programme will treat advances in topical formulations for improved skin delivery. **It will include the following topics\* and speakers.**

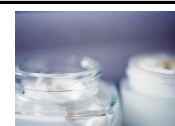

Please submit short papers **until 15 May 2019**.

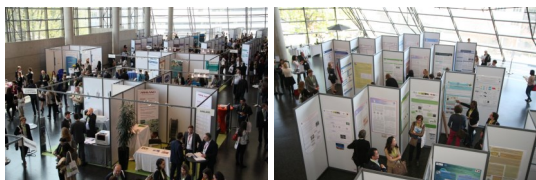
Authors will be notified of acceptance of their short paper and the type of presentation (oral or poster) by the beginning of July 2019.
